

# 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Wakefield Baptist Church Labor Day Cookout & Family Camping at Rolling View Campground!

## ***DETAILS:***

**When:** Sunday, September 5 at 4:00pm - Monday, September 6 (Labor Day). If you are not able to camp overnight, please come for swimming, games and a cookout from 4:00 - 8:00pm on Sunday. We will plan to eat dinner around 6:00pm.

**Where:** Rolling View Campground (on Falls Lake). Group Campsite #4 - See directions at the bottom

**Cost:** No cost to participate! Note that guests *not* camping overnight will be charged a \$6.00 (per vehicle) park entrance fee at the security gate.

### **What to bring for the Cookout:**

- Each family should bring their own meat/buns to grill, AND a side dish to share with the group. (Please also bring the utensil to serve your side dish).
- There are benches and picnic tables on site, but you may want a lawn chair to sit by the fire.
- There is a private swimming beach so you may swim - the water is warm.
- If you're sleeping over, please bring your own food for the morning and camping gear.
- Bug Spray

### **What will be provided:**

- All paper products including plates, napkins, silverware, and cups
- Beverages: Lemonade and Water
- Ingredients to make S'mores during the campfire
- Firewood for campfire/ charcoal for grill

### **Rules and Regulations:**

- Guests that are not camping overnight will be charged an entrance fee of \$6.00 per vehicle at the gate. If you are sleeping over, the entrance fee is waived.
- The front gate will close at 8:00pm, so those not camping need to leave by 8:00pm (or at least move their vehicle outside the gate before 8pm, and then stay for the campfire).
- Pets are welcome, but must be on a 6 ft leash or shorter at all times.

### **Directions to Rollingview Campground and our Group Campsite:**

From Wake Forest, travel West on NC 98. Once you pass Creedmoor Road (NC 50), continue West on NC 98 for exactly 5.5 miles. Turn Right onto Baptist Road (John Neal Middle School is on the corner). Baptist Road will dead-end into Rolling View Campground. From the security gate, drive straight toward the Group Camping sites. Then, turn Right at the "Group Camp" sign. We are on site #4.
