<p><b>6</b></p> <p><b>Family</b> Philippians 1:1-11</p>	<p><b>7</b></p> <p>Read this week's passage aloud as a family. Review last night's lesson with the Family Discussion Questions.</p>	<p><b>8</b></p> <p>Find Bolivia on a map. Talk about the group from our church family that will going to Bolivia in a few weeks. Pray that the people there would come to know Jesus as Lord.</p>	<p><b>9</b></p> <p>Before bed, <b>THANK</b> Jesus for blessing you with your family. Thank Him that He made each of us different. Take time and pray for each member of your family by name.</p>	<p><b>10</b></p> <p>As a family, wash the dishes together. Have everyone say the memory verse. See if anyone can say it backward.</p>	<p><b>11</b></p> <p>Over dinner, introduce this coming Sunday's topic using the "Main Idea."</p>
<p><b>13</b></p> <p><b>Trials</b> Philippians 1:12-18</p>	<p><b>14</b></p> <p>Read this week's passage aloud as a family. Review last night's lesson with the Family Discussion Questions.</p>	<p><b>15</b></p> <p>Sing "Jesus Loves Me" together as a family. Explain that even though we may experience trials in life, Jesus never stops loving us.</p>	<p><b>16</b></p> <p>Before bed, <b>ASK</b> Jesus to comfort those you know who are going through various trials. Pray that He would show you how to comfort others with His love.</p>	<p><b>17</b></p> <p>Play hide and seek as a family. After you play, thank Jesus that no matter where we may find ourselves, there is no place where we are without Him.</p>	<p><b>18</b></p> <p>As a family, practice saying the memory verse, but use different accents. Here are a few examples: British, valley girl, robot, French, etc.</p>
<p><b>20</b></p> <p><b>Happy Father's Day!</b></p>	<p><b>21</b></p> <p>Read Ephesians 6:1-4 aloud as a family. Discuss the responsibilities given to fathers and children in this passage.</p>	<p><b>22</b></p> <p>Make popcorn and watch TV as a family. Look at the different examples of fathers the media gives. Explain how these earthly fathers are different than the perfect Heavenly Father.</p>	<p><b>23</b></p> <p>Visit <a href="http://www.questforcompassion.org">www.questforcompassion.org</a> for an interactive way for your family to learn about four different countries. Pick a country to learn about and pray for.</p>	<p><b>24</b></p> <p>Before bed, pray for the Bolivia mission team that will leave in the morning. Spend time praying that Bolivia would know Jesus as Lord and Savior.</p>	<p><b>25</b></p> <p>Over dinner, introduce this coming Sunday's topic using the "Main Idea."</p>
<p><b>27</b></p> <p><b>Perspective</b> Philippians 1:19-30</p>	<p><b>28</b></p> <p>Read this week's passage aloud as a family. Review last night's lesson with the Family Discussion Questions.</p>	<p><b>29</b></p> <p>Invite a neighbor over for dinner. Use this time to get to know them. Look for ways to "let your manner of life be worthy of the Gospel" in front of them.</p>	<p><b>30</b></p> <p>Before bed, <b>CONFESS</b> that you do not always see things they way God sees them. Thank Him for always being attentive and caring for His children.</p>	<p><b>1</b></p> <p>Get some chalk and write out the memory verse on your sidewalk or driveway. See if you are able to say it without looking at the verse.</p>	<p><b>2</b></p> <p>Take time to <b>THANK</b> God as a family for the freedom we have in America to worship without fear. Pray for those around the world who do not share that same freedom.</p>
